Below you will find key changes to the 2025 Competition Rules. In all disciplines, competitors are responsible for reviewing the whole rule book.

Artistic Events

- Changes to the descriptions of the performance requirements for moves and the points assessed complete with deduction descriptions.
- Competitors should read the rules for complete information because they are too numerous to itemize in a quick announcement

Canopy Formation

- Change in the wording for rejunps due to equipment malfunction
- See rule 4.10.3 of the competition rules

Canopy Piloting

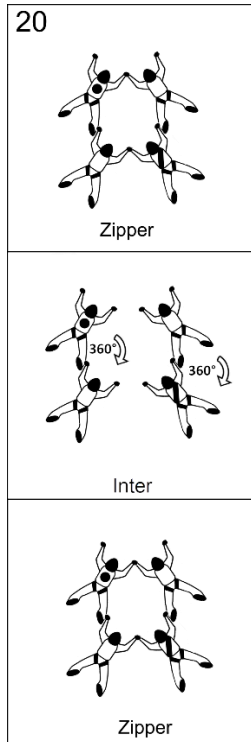
- Clarification on declaration of combined champion.

Wingsuit

- **There are some major changes to this event (both performance and acro) and competitors should read the rules thoroughly. They are too numerous to itemize. (Some (NOT ALL) are listed below)**
- Change to the definition of a wingsuit and to what is and - is not - allowed.
- Updates to Exit Definitions
- General Definitions

- Addition of Female class
- Update to GRP Assignment & Rotation
- Update to Validation Window
- Update to Proximity
- Major changes to Addendum D (Guidelines for measuring a wingsuit)
- Changes to Annex A (Acro Compulsory Sequences)

Formation Skydiving

- New wording for grip – clarification of a grip
- New arrows and indicators to include those used in VFS
- New diagram for “Visualization of grip Positions” (7.2)
- Introduction of conditional rejump (affecting definition 2.15 and rule 4.8.1)
- Dive Pool Change – Block 20 (4-way)
