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Overview

This portfolio is meant to be downloaded by yourself and used to guide you through the C3 Canopy Piloting process with the assistance of a current C3 Canopy Pilot. You can download the manual and the portfolio online. Your portfolio is used to record work on the tasks at your own pace over a maximum period of one (1) year. When you are done, submit your portfolio to the CSPA National Office (office@cspa.ca). Once your rating is processed you will receive confirmation from the National Office and your name will be listed on the CSPA website as a C3-CP rating holder.

Prerequisites

- SSE verification that the candidate is a subject matter expert in High-Performance Canopy Piloting with a safety orientated attitude
- DZO or DZSO verification that the candidate is a subject matter expert in High-Performance Canopy Piloting with a safety orientated attitude
- Submission of Technical Assessment Jump #1 and Jump #2 as per C3 CP Portfolio (video and Flysight data required with submission)

OR

Participate in two judged events or competitions (e.g. Nationals, Provincials, FLCPA)

- Coach 2 certified
- 500 jumps on a high-performance canopy verified by a SSE
- Complete the Coach 3 Common Exam (Open Book)
- Complete the Sport Canopy Endorsement and High-Performance Canopy Piloting Safety Exam (Open Book)

Training Process & Portfolio Task List

Candidates obtain portfolios <u>online</u> and then work on completing the portfolio tasks under the guidance of a current C3 – CP. Upon completion, send the portfolio to the CSPA National Office for certification. A one (1) year period is allowed to complete all tasks.

Portfolio Task List (Under Direct Supervision)

- 1. Write the Threshold Knowledge Exam Sport Canopy Endorsement and High-Performance Canopy Piloting Safety.
- 2. Write the C3 Common Exam.
- 3. Submit portfolio and appropriate signatures.
- 4. Understand the source references for Sport Canopy Endorsement and C3 CP manual.
- 5. Submission of Technical Assessment Jump #1 and Jump #2 as per C3 CP Portfolio (video and Flysight data required with submission)

OR

Participate in two judged events or competitions (e.g. Nationals, Provincials, FLCPA)

6. Act as a supervising Coach 3 CP and understand the process: Preparation, Supervision, Examination correction, Debrief and Documentation.

Roles and Tasks

- Coach High-Performance canopy piloting programs
- Mentor aspiring Coach 3s
- Be recognized within CSPA (and on website) as a subject matter expert
- Administer the Sport Canopy Endorsement
- Sign off A, B, C, and D CoP accuracy requirements

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Currency

- Teach 2 courses in two years consisting of 10 candidates or proof of intensive training or ten one-on-one candidates trained.
- 100 High-Performance canopy landings in previous 12 months

Certification

To certify your rating, you must complete the following items:

- 1. The practical component for the C3 CP requires that you complete ALL tasks as laid out in this portfolio while under the supervision of C3 CP within a 12-month period. Keep a record of your activities on the form in this portfolio and when complete, have it signed by a Certified SSE.
- 2. Your C2 ratings must be certified (i.e. the ratings must show on your affiliation card). You can start the C3 CP portfolio while you are completing a prerequisite rating. However, all prerequisites must be certified at the time your C3 CP Portfolio is submitted.

Once you have completed the above requirements, please do the following:

- 1. Maintain a copy of the Portfolio for your own personal records
- 2. Email a scanned copy of the portfolio to <u>office@cspa.ca</u>. The scanned copy must be legible and "full" sized (not reduced).

Once your rating is processed you will receive confirmation from the National Office and your name will be listed on the CSPA website as a C3-CP rating holder. You will have to renew your CSPA Affiliation and your rating as per currency requirements outlined in PIM 1.
