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#### Overview

This portfolio is meant to be downloaded by yourself and used to guide you through the C3 Wingsuit process with the assistance of a current C3 Wingsuit. You can download the manual and the portfolio from the CSPA Website (<a href="www.cspa.ca">www.cspa.ca</a>). Your portfolio is used to record work on the tasks at your own pace over a maximum period of one (1) year. When you are done, submit your portfolio to CSPA (<a href="mailto:office@cspa.ca">office@cspa.ca</a>). Once you have received your updated affiliation card with the Coach 3 – Wingsuit Rating, you become a Coach 3 Wingsuit.

### Prerequisites\*

- Succeed at one recognized wingsuit manufacturer first flight instructor course
- SSE verification that the candidate is a subject matter expert in wingsuit flight with a safety orientated attitude
- DZO or DZSO verification that the candidate is a subject matter expert in wingsuit flight with a safety orientated attitude.
- Coach 2 certified
- Minimum 100 wingsuit flights
- Verification by DZSO of safety-orientated attitude

### **Training Process & Portfolio Task List**

Candidates obtain the portfolio from the CSPA website and then work on completing the portfolio tasks under the guidance of a current C3 Wingsuit. Upon completion, send the portfolio to the office for certification. A one (1) year period is allowed to complete all tasks.

### **Portfolio Task List** (with the guidance of a current C3 WS and SSE)

- 1. Write the C3 Common Exam
- 2. Write the C3 WS Exam
- 3. Complete one of the following
  - Submission of Technical Assessment Jump #1 and Jump #2 as per C3 WS Portfolio OR
  - b. Participate in two judged events or competitions (e.g. Nationals, Provincials, acrobatics or performance competitions).
- 4. Submit completed portfolio

### **Privileges**

- Coach advanced wingsuit programs
- Conduct first-flight / initiation jumps
- Mentor aspiring Coach 3s
- Be recognized within CSPA (and on website) as a subject matter expert

### Certification

To certify your rating, you must complete the following items:

- 1. The practical component for the C3 WS requires that you complete ALL tasks as laid out in this portfolio while under the direct supervision of a C3 WS within a 12-month period. Keep a record of your activities on the form in this portfolio and when complete, have it signed by the appropriate rating holder.
- 2. Your C2 rating must be certified and current (i.e. the rating must show on your affiliation card).
- 3. You can start the C3 WS portfolio while you are completing a prerequisite rating. However, all prerequisites must be certified at the time your C3 WS Portfolio is submitted.

Once you have completed the above requirements, please do the following:

- 1. Maintain a copy of the Portfolio for your own personal records
- 2. Email a scanned copy of the portfolio to office@cspa.ca. The scanned copy must be legible and "full" sized (not reduced).

Once this is submitted and approved, a new affiliation card will be sent to you at which time will be a Coach 3 Wingsuit with the CSPA. You will have to renew your CSPA Affiliation and maintain your rating as per currency requirements outlined by the CWC.

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## Technical Assessment Jump #1 – Personal Flight Skills

Technical Assessment Jump #1 will consist of the Candidate planning and performing a flight with outside camera. The purpose of this jump is for the Candidate to prove the mastery of a wide range of wingsuit flight skills.

There are two evaluation methods for this jump:

## Evaluation Method A - Current C3 Wingsuit as Evaluator

A current C3 WS may act as the evaluator for this jump. The current C3 WS is to oversee and evaluate all requirements as described on the following page.

## Evaluation Method B - Video Submission to CWC

The Candidates may submit to the CWC (via email to <a href="mailto:office@cspa.ca">office@cspa.ca</a>) outside video of Technical Assessment Jump #1 for evaluation. The video must start no later than the time at which the Candidate begins spotting and climb-out and show the entirety of the wingsuit flight up to the pull. The Candidate must be always in-frame, and the cameraflyer must present suitable viewing angles and proximity such that all skills may be properly evaluated. The CWC reserves the right to reject any submissions that do not, in the opinion of the CWC, provide suitable presentation of the skills.

If video is to be submitted to the CWC for evaluation, the sections of *Flight Planning, Spotting and Exit, Canopy Flight, and Debrief* are to be marked by a local SSE.

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## **Technical Assessment Jump #2 – Coaching Flight Skills**

Technical Assessment Jump #2 will consist of the Candidate executing a wingsuit flight in the role of the coach. The candidate will be evaluated on their ability to maintain safe proximity to the novice while performing in-air skill analysis.

Technical Assessment Jump #2 is recommended to be performed with a current C3 WS acting as the novice.

The jump will follow the Dive Flow described in *Level Five: Barrel Roll, Instability Recovery*, as described in the C3 WS Reference Guide. On the first and third barrel rolls, the "novice" will become unstable and enter a brief dive and eventual recovery. The task is for the Candidate to maintain reasonable and safe proximity.

There are two evaluation methods for this jump:

#### Evaluation Method A - Current C3 Wingsuit as Evaluator

A current C3 WS may act as the evaluator for this jump. The current C3 WS is to oversee and evaluate all requirements as described on the following page. Evaluation of the *Wingsuit Flight* portion of the jump should be completed through both the C3 WS (acting novice) recall of the jump, as well as a review of the Candidates video of the acting novice.

## Evaluation Method B - Video Submission to CWC

The Candidates may submit to the CWC (via email to <a href="mailto:office@cspa.ca">office@cspa.ca</a>) the Candidates video of the acting novice for evaluation. The video must start no later than the time at which the Candidate begins spotting and climb-out and show the entirety of the wingsuit flight up to the pull. The CWC will evaluate the Candidates ability to maintain safe proximity to the acting novice. The Candidate must always keep the novice in-frame. The CWC reserves the right to reject any submissions that do not, in the opinion of the CWC, provide suitable presentation of the skills.

If video is to be submitted to the CWC for evaluation, the sections of *Flight Planning, Spotting and Exit, Canopy Flight, and Debrief and Skill Analysis* are to be marked by a local SSE.
