Item #1 - Javelin Odyssey Immediate Inspection

Sun Path Products Inc. have issued Service Bulletin SPSB005 that affects all sport Javelin Odyssey Harness/Container Systems with Hip Ring or 4 Ring main lift web, with a date of manufacture between <u>September 2008 and December 2008</u>.

It was brought to their attention that the hip ring on JH101-3 (Hip ring only) and JH101-4 (4-ring) main lift webs may have been struck by the machine needle used for installing the 5 cord harness stitching. A needle strike on the hip ring may cause damage to the Type 12 buffer, 5 cord stitching and possibly the Type 7 webbing itself. As a precaution, immediate mandatory inspection of the hip rigs is required for all systems with a date of manufacture between **September 2008 and December 2008**.

If damage is found, the harness/container system will need to be returned to Sun Path Products.
